WHAT IS STUDENT OFFICE?


The Student Office is the administrative department of registration for students at IPAG.


Student Office Information

While you are studiyng at IPAG, your learning and progression will be assessed in different ways, such as individual exam, essays, reports and presentations, as well as individual and group participation.

CLASSROOM ETIQUETTE



The use of mobile phones in class will not be tolerated; in this case, professors may with hold your phone from you until the end of the class. Attendance is compulsory - any unexplained abscences will be reported. All students must be punctual and arrive on time. If you arrive late, this will be reported

ATTENDANCE

In order to get the most from your academic experience at IPAG, attendance and punctuality are mandatory for each and every class. Regular unauthorized absences or tardiness will have a negative impact on your continuous assessment mark. Attendance is taken by professors at the beginning of each class, and this information is provided to the school administration on a regular basis. More than three unauthorized abscences will result in your being withdrawn from the programme.

Students who are regularly absent, whether authorized or not, may be subject to additional academic penalties. Any student who arrives to class after attendance has been taken will be marked as a late arrival and/or absent.

WELCOME TO NICE

For overseas students, we have put together some useful information for getting started in Nice, such as tips on opening a bank, phones, social security, transport, as well as fun things to do in Nice!

BANKS

Having a French bank account is very useful as it avoids exchange rate charges and your card is a lot more widely accepted. Unlike other countries, you need to pay to open an account in France (such as cost of a bank card and monthly fees). Therefore, you should look for banks which offer student deals to select the best package for you.

PHONE

Many services offered in Nice require a French telephone number (such as getting a travel pass). One way of getting around this is buying a pre-paid sim card which you top up when you need to. Alternatively, you can find good phone deals offered by some of the phone companies shown. We recommend Free.fr as they offer some of the best deals within some contracts which you can end at any time.

• Vélobleu: Nice Côte d'Azur offers its visitors a different way of exploring the destination by following the 125 kilometres of cycle tracks now in operation across the metropolitan area. More and more tourists are choosing to use this ecological way of travelling around. A variety of options are available for occasional and regular users.

The Ligne d'Azumetwork offers you:

More than 130 bus day-time bus routes in the 49 towns of Nice Côte d'Azur

Noctambus: 5 night-time bus routes from 9:10 pm to 10:10 am

The tramway:

- N° 1 linethrough the city centre along the avenue Jean Médecin and through the Place Masséna 21 hours a day! Every day from 4:25am to 1:35am
- N° 2 line offers a west-east connection from the airport to the Jean Médecin station (city centre) and terminates at the port
- N° 3 line provides an airport connection to Saint Isidore

A combined bus/tram ticket with many connection possibilities a Solo ticket for one journey allowing changes within 74 min for 1,50 €

Social security registration is mandatory and free of charge and will entitle you to reimbursement of your healh care expenses.

Heyme is health insurance that is aimed at students. Cover include: "Civil responsibility" for insternships and daily life, and repatriation assistance (in France) for you stay abroad. There are four levels of cover with prices ranging from 9,90€/month to 39,90€, which incluedes cover for dental tratment and hospitalisation.


